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PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS FALLFEST PARADE ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 AT 7 PM

1. Parade formation will be on Monroe Street. Participants should enter from Englar Road.
2. Please follow instructions from the Police Officer on duty.
3. Only Parade vehicles will be allowed beyond the drop off point. Parade vehicles should arrive between 5:45 and 6:30 p.m. Walkers and riders must be dropped off and walk to the formation area. Buses will not be allowed to stop on Monroe Street to unload passengers – they should pull into West Middle School or St. John’s Church lots to unload.
4. The Parade will leave the formation area shortly after 7 p.m. (*the Fallfest Road Mile Race will be run just ahead of the Parade*) and will progress down Pennsylvania Avenue, to a left on MainStreet, then a left on Longwell Avenue to disbandment at East Middle School.
5. Any group not ready to enter the formation when called upon will be moved to the rear of the Parade.
6. It will be necessary for all groups to move forward as promptly as possible. Performance in front of the judging stand (*on Longwell Avenue near the Armory*) will be limited to 2 minutes. Committee members will be along the Parade route to ensure that the Parade moves forward promptly. Failure to comply could result in disqualification in any judging and participation in future Parades.
7. Handouts of any kind (*fliers, signs, buttons, etc.*) from anyone within the Parade are strictly prohibited. Violators will be removed.
8. Throwing candy is not permitted. Treats may be handed out along the parade route.
9. Animal units must provide manure clean-up or be moved to the end of the Parade formation.
10. No political entries accepted.

Presentation of awards will be on Thursday, Sept. 24 **after the Parade** on the Food Court stage. All participants are encouraged to attend.
